General Terms and Conditions

1. Applicability

These General Terms and Conditions (hereafter referred to as the «GTC») apply to all services (hereafter referred to as the Services») or the «Surf Trips») of Surfboat / Thomas Becks & Eric Kuenzi (hereafter referred to as «Surfboat») obtainable by the customer (hereafter referred to as the «Customer») from Surfboat. Overriding terms or terms that deviate from the T&C shall apply only after Surfboat has expressly confirmed this in writing.

2. Conclusion of contract

Offers of Surfboat are non-binding. The amount of participants is limited and Services can be declined without reason. The Customer places the order by completing the order form which Surfboat makes available on the Internet. Surfboat confirms acceptance of the order by sending a confirmation by email. The agreement is concluded by the issuing of a confirmation by Surfboat. These GTC are deemed to have been accepted by the Customer by placing the order with the order form.

3. Prices / Services / Terms of payment

The prices for the Services and the Services are described on the website of Surfboat. The Customer acknowledges that he has read the description of the Services on the website of Surfboat. The price is payable in the currency mentioned in the pricelist on the website. The price for the Services is due at least 5 weeks before the start of the booked Surf Trip. Surfboat reserves the right to adapt the prices under certain circumstances such as but not limited to: increase of prices of lease of safari boat, increase of petrol prices, introduction of new taxes or increase of existing taxes, inflation. In case of such changes, Surfboat will inform the Customer immediately.

4. Cancellation and changes of bookings – Customer

From the point of confirmation by Surfboat, the order may no longer be cancelled by the Customer. There won't be any refunds in case of cancellation or booking changes. The Customer can look for a replacement but Surfboat recommends the contracting of a private travel cancellation insurance.

5. Cancellation – Surfboat

Surfboat reserves the right to cancel Surf Trips due to, amongst others, the following reasons: Political tumult, strike, act of god, or lack of participants.

In case of lack of participants, the Customer shall be informed of the cancellation by email or letter at least 3 weeks before the Surf Trip takes place.

In case of cancellation of the Services by Surfboat, all participants will receive a complete refund. Surfboat is not liable for any further compensation or damages.

6. Travel, visa and health requirements

The Customer is responsible for the transportation to the place where the Services are rendered, for the full fulfillment of the visa requirements and the mandatory vaccinations.

7. Risk

The Customer acknowledges that the Surf Trips take place in remote areas where medical and other help is limited. The Customer further acknowledges that the practice of surfing is dangerous, especially in remote areas and on a coral reef bottom. The Customer confirms that he is in perfect physical and psychological condition for the Trip and has the necessary surf abilities to participate on a Surf Trip.

8. Liability

Surfboat is liable for direct damages resulting from a gross negligence or intent. Surfboat is not liable for services rendered by third parties. Any other liability is excluded.

Further, the Customer is solely responsible for risks resulting from the practice of surfing.

9. Insurance

All Customers are responsible for their own insurances (sickness, accident, travel cancellation, cost of repatriation, luggage – etc.).

10. Applicable law, place of jurisdiction

The present GTS are governed exclusively by Swiss law. The provisions of the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods (signed in Vienna on 11 April 1980) are expressly excluded.

The exclusive place of jurisdiction is Basel (Switzerland).
